- Automobile batteries (lead-acid)
- Computers, TVs & e-waste (defined by statute) effective July 1 2013
- PCBs
- Radioactive wastes
- Tires (Residential whole)
- Volatile and flammable waste
- Liquid waste or waste that has free-liquids (particularly waste oil, paint, septage, contaminated water or liquids)
- Sludges, septic tank pumpings, or chemical toilet wastes not approved by county and CDPHE (dewatered/denatured POTW sludge approved)
- Institutional wastes considered biomedical or biohazardous
- Unlabeled 55 gallon drums (not empty),
- Industrial process waste not pre-approved by county and / or CDPHE (Requires content/chemical documentation)
- Yellow grease (restaurant kitchen grease traps)
