

The Board of County Commissioners of Montezuma County, Colorado met in special reorganization session Tuesday, January 9, 1951, at 8:30 A.M.

Nominations for Chairman for the year 1951 were called for. Commissioner Porter nominated J. C. Rumburg. Commissioner Clampitt seconded the nomination. Question: Commissioner Porter voted aye; Commissioner Clampitt voted aye; Commissioner Rumburg refrained. Commissioner Rumburg as Chairman announced the election of J. C. Rumburg as Chairman of the Board of Commissioners for the year 1951.

The following appointments were made: as County Physicians at a salary of \$20.00 each per month, Dr. H. R. Rasor, Dr. Richard T. Speck, Dr. E. G. Merritt, Dr. Clifford M. Paraley, Dr. M. J. Karkeang, Dr. I. E. Maxwell and Dr. V. E. Gardner.

Ralph L. McKee, Registered Accountant, as County Auditor at a salary of \$600.00 per annum, for the years 1951 and 1952.

Glenn R. Grace, as Bea Inspector at a salary of \$8.00 per day plus mileage.

James B. Garrison, as County Attorney at a salary of \$75.00 per month for the year of 1951.

Harry W. Curtis, as Custodian of the Court House at a salary of \$160.00 per month.

Jack Allum, Shop Foreman at a salary of \$264.20 per month.

Dick Elliott, Foreman Road District Number 1, at a salary of \$232.20 per month.

Robert P. Page, Foreman Road District Number 2, at a salary of \$232.20 per month.

Lawson Bowling, Foreman Road District Number 3, at a salary of \$232.20 per month.

Otis W. Baysinger, Foreman Crusher, at a salary of \$232.20 per month.

The Board of Commissioners confirmed the appointments of Ella Sue Livingston as Deputy County Clerk at a salary of \$150.00 per month; H. Dusin Caylor, Deputy County Treasurer, same salary; Iris Ferrari as Deputy County Assessor, same salary. The Board also confirmed the appointment of Paul J. Covey, as County Agent at a salary of \$4000.00 per year.

The following official bonds were examined and found to be in order: Charles T. Porter as County Commissioner; Grady Clampitt as County Commissioner; M. W. Anderson as Sheriff; John Leavitt as County Clerk and Recorder; Ray Wilson as County Assessor, Lois S. Miller as County Treasurer; Latta W. Managh as County Superintendent of Schools; Guy O. Harrison as Justice of the Peace; Homer H. Selbe as Justice of the Peace; Harry E. Pyle as Justice of the Peace; William H. Williams as Justice of the Peace; Lin Crawford as Constable and Anna Patten as Clerk of the County Court. All bonds were approved by the Commissioners and ordered filed.

The following resolutions were adopted:

RESOLUTION

It is hereby Resolved by the Board of Commissioners of Montezuma County, in session assembled, that Forest Service Funds to Montezuma County be apportioned 50% to School Funds and 50% to County Road Fund.

RESOLUTION

Be it Resolved by the Board of Commissioners of Montezuma County, Colorado in regular session assembled this 9th day of January, 1951, that the following policy be, and the same is hereby adopted and approved in the matter of Tax Certificates held by Montezuma County.

Sale of certificate shall not be permitted to any person, firm, association or corporation on land when such person, firm, association or corporation has any record interest therein, either as record owner, mortgagee or leasee.

Offers, when accepted by this Board, shall be the warrant and authority of the County Treasurer of Montezuma County, Colorado, TO ACCEPT AS LOW AS THE SUM SO OFFERED, PLUS Treasurer's Fees, and if sale be not completed within thirty days from the date of authorization by the Board of County Commissioners, order authorizing such sale shall be void and of no further force and effect.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Treasurer of Montezuma County, Colorado, has in his hand and control, certain moneys, and will from time to time receive additional funds, from collection of taxes, as well as other sources; and

WHEREAS, Be it Resolved by the Board of Commissioners of Montezuma County, Colorado, that the Citizens State Bank, of Cortez, and the J. J. Harria & Company, Bankers, Bank, Dolores Colorado, Be, and are hereby named, designated, constituted and appointed depository banks for all funds and moneys of whatsoever kind, that shall come into the possession of the County Treasurer by virtue of his office as County Treasurer of Montezuma County, Colorado, and said banks, and each of them herein named, are approved as depository banks.
