Show Rules

Rules and patterns used for 4-H Open shows and gymkhana will come from *Colorado 4-H Horse Show Rule Book 2015*. "The rules encourage judging and competition that reflect the standards of skill and abilities in horsemanship emphasized by the Colorado 4-H Horse Program."

Novice Classes – For 4-H beginner riders (any age), young horses enrolled in the Owner/Trainer project, and 4-H members who have not received a placing above 4th place. ***This is a non-competitive class for beginner 4-H members to be introduced to horse showing or to introduce their young horses to the show ring.*** All patterns will be design for beginners and contestants are allowed to ride 2-handed. Although a contestant that performs well one-handed will be given more consideration. Contestants that participate in these classes are NOT eligible for the *Year End All Round Champion Award*, but will be awarded a *Series Award* in July. Contestant may crossover and show in their age group on a different horse. Once a contestant has won a champion award they are not permitted to show in Novice classes the following year. The May and June show will be walk/trot only and the July show will be walk/trot/lope (canter).

Cloverbud Classes – Kids 5-7 years old, does not have to be enrolled in 4-H

Open Classes – For anyone 19 and over or any youth who is not enrolled 4-H.

Protective Headgear Policy *rule book pg 2*

Because 4-H promotes safety first, we require a certified equestrian helmet with safety harness fastened in place for over fences classes and all gymkhana events. Protective head gear may be used in all classes and shall not be discriminated against. La Plata County 4-H Horse Council will provide helmets for those who do not have one.

Points scale and awards- Contestant must attend 2 of the 3 horse shows and be present at the July show to be eligible for end of the series awards. There will be a champion buckle for combined English and Western points in Open, Senior, Intermediate, and Junior age groups. A trophy will be awarded to Novice and Cloverbud champions for combined English and Western points. Other prizes will be awarded through 5th place overall, in the English and Western separately, *if* we have enough contestants and sponsorship. The overall score will reflect points from **ALL** 3 horse shows. The points scale as follows:
