RECYCLING

At this time, the landfill purchases old corrugate cardboard, old mixed paper, and plastics numbers 1 and 2 for recycling. The landfill also collects scrap metal for our local salvage yards. The landfill purchasing price of recyclable commodities is the fair market value of the commodity less the landfill's cost to process them. Because the markets fluctuate monthly please call the office in advance to check the current month's prices.

THE MONTEZUMA COUNTY LANDFILL DOES NOT ACCEPT GLASS FOR RECYCLING AT THIS TIME.

Hybrid-Single-Stream Recycling

Some haulers in the area offer curbside recycling to county residents. In order to keep

the cost of recycling as low as possible please separate and prepare commodities for your cart as follows: leave old cardboard loose, please remove labels and lids from plastics #s 1 and 2 and securely bag them together. Securely bag all old mixed paper together. Please remove labels from and rinse aluminum and tin cans and bag them securely together. This bagging process allows for efficient sorting of recyclable materials. Thank you.

PROHIBITED ITEMS

- Biohazard Waste: medical, infectious, and radioactive (no red bag waste type allowed)
- Friable Asbestos
- Hazardous Waste
- Hot ashes (e.g. fireplaces, burn barrels)
- Lead acid batteries (e.g. car & trucks)
- Liquids: (paint, oil, septage, chemicals)

If there is a question, call the office and ask **BEFORE** trying to dispose of an item.

ELECTRONICS

By law, waste electronics and computers from residential and non-residential sources cannot be disposed of in solid waste landfills in Colorado. The following rate structure applies for recycling electronics.
