

2019- Montezuma County Weed Program Low Income / Disability Cost-Share Application

Age & Disability Requirements

You have to be 65 years or older, or, with a permanent and a total disability.

A **permanent and total disability** means that you can't engage in or perform any "substantial gainful activity" because of a physical or mental condition. Substantial gainful activities are tasks or duties that you do for pay. It doesn't include things that you do to care for yourself, like bathing or getting dressed. It also doesn't include things you do for free, like hobbies. Generally, a doctor has to certify that your physical or mental condition can result in death or has lasted or can be expected to last for a continuous 12-month period.

Income Limitations

Even if you satisfy the other requirements, you can apply for the cost share only if your income is below a certain level. This level is based upon your adjusted gross income (AGI) or your non-taxable benefits, like Social Security and pension payments.

- **Single, head of household or a qualifying widow** - your AGI is \$17,500 or lower.
- **Married filing jointly and you and your wife satisfy the other requirements** - your AGI is \$25,000 or lower.
- **Married filing jointly and you only satisfy the other requirements** - your AGI is \$20,000 or lower.
- **Married filing separately** - your AGI is \$12,500 or lower.

6. Applications will be reviewed by the Weed Supervisor and the Noxious Weed Advisory Board of Montezuma County.

8. ***Application review and fund disbursement is on a first come, first served basis.***

Common tansy, Cutleaf teasel, Spotted knapweed, Diffuse knapweed, Russian knapweed, Yellow toadflax, Dalmatian toadflax, Yellow Starthistle, Myrtle spurge, Leafy spurge, Mediterranean sage, Scentless chamomile, Mayweed chamomile, Musk thistle, Canada thistle, Scotch thistle, Bull thistle, Plumless thistle, Russian thistle, Eurasian watermilfoil, Houndstongue, Hoary cress, Oxeye daisy, Perennial pepperweed, Russian olive, Salt cedar, Sulfur cinquefoil, Halogeton, Chicory, Common burdock, Common mullein, Downy brome, Field bindweed, Poison hemlock, Puncturevine, and Redstem filaree.

Leafy Spurge infestations will be managed by the County Weed Program at no cost to the landowner.
