The County further agrees that after the said project has been completed it will thereafter maintain the same to the satisfaction of the U.S. Bureau of Public Roads and of the State Highway Department; and that if, at any time after the construction of said project, the County shall fail to maintain the same as by the Federal Highway Act provided and défined, the State Highway Department may at once proceed to place the same in a condition satisfactory to the U.
