The Board of County Commissioners, Montezuma County, met in regular session Monday, February 3rd, 1930, at ten o'clock A. M.

The minutes of the meetings of December 2nd and 3rd, 1929 and January 6th and 7th, 1930, were read and approved.

Fred E. Smith appeared before the Board and reported the destitute condition of Mrs. Hunt, near Dolores. Without motion the Board ordered the Clerk to give Mrs. Hunt an order on the W. J. Exon Merc. Co. for \$20.00 for groceries and clothing, as temporary aid. The Clerk was also instructed to ascertain the names and addresses of the children of Mrs. Hunt, and write them by registered mail of the necessity of their reimbursing the Board to this amount and their caring for their mother in the future.

Mr. Glen Grace appeared before the Board relative to some apiary inspection work necessary at this time. Mr. Grace was instructed to look after such temporary

It having come to the attention of the Board that there is at present time in the hands of the County Treasurer the sum of \$6,282.53 derived from Forest Service fees; it was thereupon ordered that 95% of said amount be apportioned to the General Road Fund, and 5% to the General School Fund of the County.

J. M. Brumley, County Judge, appeared before the Board and reported the abandonment of young children belonging to D. C. Thomas, the children being at present with Mrs. A. L. Bunce of Summit Ridge. Without motion, warrant was ordered drawn in favor of Mrs. Bunce for \$20.00 to cover the expense of their care for January, and Mr. Brumley was requested to make effort to locate Mr. Thomas and notify him of his legal responsibility for the care of his children, or to in some way find a home for these children.

It having been brought to the attention of the Board that at present time there is an overdraft in the County Poor Fund and that there is a surplus in the Contingent Fund, it is therefore ordered by the Board that the County Treasurer transfer the sum of \$200.00 from the Contingent Fund to the Poor Fund.

Moved that the reports of the auditors covering the receipts and disbursements of offices of County Treasurer and County Clerk be accepted and same ordered filed.

The following bonds were approved and ordered placed on record: S. W. Carpenter, County Attorney; H. C. Honaker, Road Overseer; W. C. Longenbaugh, Road Overseer and Chas. B. Neeley, Road Overseer.

It was ordered that the 1922 taxes should be declared unavailable.

The following agreement having been submitted to the Board by the Forest Service, same was accepted by the Board, signed, and the Clerk instructed to return it to Mr. A. T. Hoffman, Forest Supervisor:

This agreement, made this 3rd day of February, 1930, by and between the Board of County Commissioners of Montezuma County, State of Colorado, hereinafter referred to as the County Commissioners, and the District Forester of the Rocky Mountain District, United States Forest Service, hereinafter referred to as the District Forester;

WITNESSETH: That, Whereas, it will be to the advantage of both parties here-

top of Dunlap Hill, or so far as the funds will permit, all in Montezuma County, Colorado;

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises and the several promises to be faithfully performed each, the parties hereby agree as follows:

A. The County Commissioners agree: (1) To reconstruct and improve, or cause to be reconstructed and improved by widening and improving the surface thereof, the section of the Dolores-Norwood Road No. 432 above described.

2. To provide the road building equipment, labor and materials necessary to perform the reconstruction and improvement herein contemplated.

3. To keep an accurate account of all amounts expended in the said reconstruction and improvement, and to perform the work as efficiently and economically as possible.

4. To have such reconstruction and improvement completed by June 30, 1930.

B. The District Forester agrees: (1) Upon the approval by the Supervisor of the Montezuma National Forest of the reconstruction and improvement of that portion of the Dolores-Norwood Road No. 432 above described, and the submission to the District Forester by the County Commissioners of itemized certified statements of the expenses incurred in such reconstruction and improvement, which statements shall be approved by the Supervisor of the Montezuma National Forest, to pay to the Treasurer of Montezuma County, Colorado fifty per centum (50%) of such expenses, provided the total of such payments to be made by the District Forester shall, in no event, exceed the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500.00).

In the matter of the assessment of 3,000 shares of water held in the name of the Cortez Land & Securities Company, assessed to the Montezuma Valley Irrigation Company without land, cause No. 975 on the docket of the District Court of Montezuma County, Colorado, the Board being advised that said assessment cannot be sustained in law, it is ordered by the Board that the County Attorney be and he is hereby authorized and directed to consent with the attorney for the Montezuma Valley Irrigation Company that judgment be entered in said proceeding for the cancellation of said assessment.

In the matter of the request of Victor A. Miller, Receiver for The Rio Grande Southern Railroad Company that Montezuma County either abate, or favor a reduction of assessed valuation of the Rio Grande Southern Ry., the Clerk was instructed to write Mr. Miller that the Board does not find it consistent to grant the request.

W. Caylor by registered mail accordingly.

It appearing to the Board of County Commissioners of Montezuma County, Colorado, that a portion of State Highway No. 106 of the State of Colorado, as hereinafter described has been relocated, and that because of such relocation said portion of the route of said Highway as it theretofore existed is no longer necessary as a public highway, and in the opinion of this Board should be considered as abandoned, and the title thereto revert to the owner or owners of the land through which such abandoned portion may lie; and that said portion of said highway is not necessary for use as a public highway, said portion of said highway being described as follows: beginning at the southeast corner of Section 27, Township 36 N. Minutes of meetings of October 8th and 16th, November 3rd, 5th, 17th and 18th were read and approved.

In the matter of application of Mrs. B. M. Garner for Poor relief, it was agreed by the Board that Mrs. Garner be allowed \$10.00 per month until further orders of the Board, same to be paid by County warrant.

Mrs. C. H. Ormiston and Bert Hall of Mancos appeared before the Board, asking that the Board consider a different apportionment of the fees to be received from the Forest Service than has been made by the Board in former years, the applicants asking that a larger amount be apportioned the schools of the county. Action was deferred until such time as the fees in question are received by the County Treasurer.

Mervin Tozer appeared before the Board asking that rock be removed from the McElmo road and certain fencing of the road be done. The matter was referred to the road overseer.

Mr. Ira Harmon of Dolores appeared before the Board, asking that the Board grant him poor relief in the form of a loan until such time as he shall have an income from his properties. The matter was referred to Chairman Runck for investigation and action.

Moved by Mr. Englehart that the following resolution be adopted:

Resolved, that the balance in the Contingent Fund at the close of business on November 30, 1930, be transferred to the Ordinary County Revenue Fund, know as the "O.C.R. Fund"; and that money in said O.C.R. Fund at said date, together with any money that may accrue to said O.C.R. Fund from collection of taxes or other sources due prior to said date, together with the money in or accruing to the O. C. R. Warrants Redemption Fund, be applied to the payment of outstanding unpaid warrants registered on the O. C. R. Fund; and that claims allowed on obligations chargeable to the O. C. R. Fund accruing prior to December 1, 1930, and remaining unpaid by warrants, be paid by warrants drawn against said O. C. R. Warrants Redemption Fund, the same to be made payable in anticipation of the collection of taxes of 1930 levied for said fund. Seconded by Mr. Menefee and carried.
