Minutes of the meeting of April 6th read and approved.

Representative Fred C. Hallar met with the Board and told of his having secured the promise of an additional amount from the Budget of the State Highway Department, making approximately \$18,000 that would be available for the grading and graveling of the Cortez-Mancos Highway, providing the County would <sup>furnish</sup> loan its equipment for the work, it being estimated that in this way about two miles of road could be completed, commencing at this end of the gravel section and working this way towards Cortez. The Board approved the plan as outlined by Mr. Hallar and agreed to furnish the County equipment for this work.

A communication received from the Association of County Commissioners of Colorado relative to the taking of legal action to test the constitutionality of the old age pension act approved March 3rd, 1931 was read. It appearing from such communication that the officers of said association are advised that the old age pension act is unconstitutional and said association has called a meeting of the County attorneys of the State to consider the advisability of testing the act in the Courts;

Now Therefore, be it resolved, that the Board will give its support to whatever action may be hereafter taken by the Association of County Commissioners with respect to said matter.

An order was passed that the Clerk be instructed to write the State Psychopathic Hospital and have Van Derlin removed to the State Insane Asylum; also asking them to notify us what disposition they make of the case.

Butcher bond of Robert M. Becher with John R. Becher and Albert J. Seeger as sureties, was approved and ordered placed on file.

Moved and seconded that the bill of the Rio Grande Southern Ry., for the expense of the relocation of the telegraph line along the right of way, Dolores-Rico Highway, in the amount of \$634.79, be allowed and that warrant be drawn upon the road fund for said amount.

Mr. A. F. Hoffman, County Extension Agent appeared before the Board and outlined his plan for experimenting in the killing of poison weeds along the stock driveways of the County. The Board agreed to order a quantity of Atlacide Calcium Chlorate for this purpose.

A resolution was passed whereby the amount to be expended by the Apiary Inspector, Glenn R. Grace, for salary and expense, shall not exceed the sum of \$250. for the entire season.

In re the application of C. C. Schay and wife for poor relief, same was considered, and it was agreed that \$20.00 per month be allowed <sup>said</sup> applicants until further orders of the Board.
