Minutes of the meetings of the Board held January 10th and 29th and February 5th were read and approved as read.

Mrs. Maud Bryce appeared before the Board and made protest against the amount of taxes assessed against the W. H. Harrison property. It was suggested by the Board that the matter be taken up with the County Assessor if it was felt that there had been an over-assessment on the property.

Mrs. Louise Rowe appeared before the Board and asked for an order from the Board in regard to the ownership of a car which stands in her name. The Board suggested that Mrs. Rowe take the matter up with the County Assessor and get his recommendation before any action by the Board in the matter.

Mr. W. E. Lyen of Mancos appeared before the Board in regard to the County purchasing a Ford pickup from the Mancos Motor Co., said car to be used in the Mancos district. It was moved by Mr. Philley, seconded by Mr. Porter that the Board purchase the Ford pickup, price net to be \$594.28, and that warrant be drawn in favor of the Mancos Motor Co. for that amount. Carried.

Owing to the fact that Spring is opening up much earlier than usual, it was decided that Mr. Miller should commence Prairie Dog Extermination work earlier than the time set at the last meeting of the Board, and the Clerk was instructed to write Mr. Miller to commence work Monday, March 12th.

Mr. C. R. Neal appeared before the Board in regard to a reduction in taxes he wishes made on some land that had been deeded back to him. It was explained by the Board that such action cannot be taken by the Board, and the matter was laid on the table.

Mrs. Bell of Mancos appeared before the Board and made request for financial assistance in having her two girls operated upon for removal of tonsils. The matter was referred to the C W A.

The request of Frank Wheeler for the purchase of a tax sale certificate was denied.

The request of Sol Lybyer in re the purchase of a tax sale certificate was laid on the table.

Petition of W. R. McCabe for a rebate of taxes for 1932 in the amount of \$63.51 on account of having paid in full on cattle when he should have paid on half of them, they having been also assessed in Utah and taxes paid on them in Utah.

And the Board deeming it for the best interests of the County to dispose of said Tax Sale Certificate No. 8178, it was ordered by the Board that the County Treasurer be, and he is hereby authorized and directed to sell the same for the following price and upon the following terms, to-wit:

For Tax Sale Certificate No. 8178 the sum of \$1.00 for the sale and \$24.00 for subsequent taxes, plus treasurer's fees, providing this order is taken up within thirty days from date.

The following agreement was entered into by and between Montezuma County, of the first part, and Willard Wheeler and Wiley Sheek of the second part, this 5th day of November, 1934, WITNESSETH:

In consideration of the delivery to Montezuma County within sixty days from November 15, 1934 by Willard Wheeler and Wiley Sheek of 7,000 feet of pine bridge plank, dimensions 3 x 12 x 16 and 4 x 12 x 16, at the saw mill to be set up by Willard Wheeler and Wiley Sheek in East Canon, Mancos, Colorado, the said Montezuma County agrees that title to one Case engine shall pass to the said Willard Wheeler and Wiley Sheek upon the completion of delivery of lumber; that the said Willard Wheeler and Wiley Sheek shall have possession of said engine for use in said saw mill, but it is agreed that in the event the said Willard Wheeler and Wiley Sheek shall fail to make delivery of said lumber within the time specified, they will return said Case engine to the County at its yards in Cortez, Colorado, without expense to the County, at once.

In re the petition of H. J. Wilhelm for an abatement of taxes of 1933 in the amount of \$6.43 on account of having been assessed with a truck and had been allowed no exemption on account of being the head of a family, the following resolution was passed:

The following resolution was adopted, upon motion by Mr. Philley, seconded by Mr. Menefee:

Resolved: That pursuant to the provisions of section 8796 of the Colorado compiled laws of 1921 as amended, J. J. Harris and Company, Bankers located at Dolores, Colorado, and The First National Bank of Durango, Colorado, be and are hereby approved and designated as two of the depositories for all funds and moneys coming into the possession of the County Treasurer of Montezuma County by virtue of his office as such County Treasurer.
