

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session on Monday, March 1, 1937, at 10:00 o'clock A. M. There were present:

Minutes of the previous meetings were read and approved.

A delegation from Mancos met with the Board and the Weber Mill Road was discussed. It was decided to get further information in regard to just what help could be obtained from the CCC Camp.

It appearing to the Board that the County is the owner of Tax Sale Certificate #3452 covering the 1929 taxes on a tract of land 100 ft. square near Lewis, Colo. and deeming it to be to the best interest of the County to dispose of said sale, it was ordered by the Board that the County Treasurer be and he is hereby authorized and directed to sell the same for the sum of \$1.00 and the amount of \$23.70 for all subsequent taxes plus Treasurer's fees.

Resolution was passed extending the time for thirty days on the sale of Tax Sale Certificates #9050 and #9549.


Resolution was passed allowing the County Agent to give part of his time to Dolores County provided that Dolores County would pay his expenses while working for them.

Resolution was passed agreeing to lease the Poor Farm to Mr. Aud Sphar for a cash rental of \$350.00 per year, the County agreeing to purchase 500# of sweet clover seed and 300# of alfalfa seed to be planted on farm this year. The County Attorney was instructed to draw up lease and chattel mortgage and have Mr. Sphar sign.

A petition for rebate of taxes was presented by the Montezuma Lumber Company in the amount of \$396.24 on their 1935 taxes and interest of \$67.54. Said petition stated error had been made in classification and valuation of lumber and tractors for said year. After having been approved by the County Assessor the petition was allowed subject to the action of the Colorado Tax Commission.

An offer of the flat taxes for Tax Sale Certificate #9627 covering the 1931 taxes on the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec 10, Twp 36, R 16 and the flat tax for all subsequent taxes and an offer of \$200.00 for Sale #8057 covering the 1928 taxes on the S $\frac{1}{2}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec 12, Twp 36, R 17 and all subsequent taxes, were rejected.






