Whereas, the matter of the consideration of the petition for abatement of taxes for the years 1928 to 1937 inclusive, heretofore assessed on the property in Montezuma County of the Rio Grande Southern Railroad Company, was taken up hefore the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Monteguma at a duly and lawfully called regular meeting of said Board held on the 2nd day of May, A. D. 1938, at which meeting there were present J. L. Martin, Frank Philley and W. R. Mc Cabe, Commissioners; notice of such meeting and an opportunity to be present having been given to the County Assessor of said County of Montezuma and said Montezuma County Assessor of said County being then and there present,

Whereas, the said County Commissioners having carefully considered the petition hereinafter described and are fully advised in relation thereto, and after hearing was had, find all and singular the allegations thereof to be true;

And Whereas, it further appears that said abatement petition is a part of the proceedings of a plan and stipulation for a general reorganization of the Rio Grande Southern Railroad Company, entered into by all of the Counties wherein said railroad property exists, and all creditors, bond holders, stockholders, the corporation itself and its receiver in an equity receivership proceeding affecting said railroad corporation now pending in the United States District Court for the District of Colorado; and that said County of Montezuma has given and indicated its assent to said general plan of reorganization of said railroad;

THEREFORE HE IT HEREIN RESOLVED AND ORDERED: That in consideration of and contingent upon the completion of the reorganization of the Rio Grande Southern Railroad in accordance with the agreement and stipulation for the reorganization thereof heretofore referred to, the petition of Victor A. Miller, Receiver of the Rio Grande Southern Railroad Company, for the abatement of taxes, which petition was filed on the 2nd day of May A. personsto act as such Arbitrators;

Now Therefore Be It Resolved, that Harry V. Pyle, Eri Neel and C. H. Hady be accepted by the County as the Arbitrators to settle and determine the differences between the County and the Landowners with respect to such demages and that the contract of arbitration presented shall be duly executed by the Chairman of the Board on behalf of the County.

The following was then accepted and signed:

WITHESETH, That whereas certain centroversies now exist between the party of the first part and the parties of the second part as to the value and damages thereto, placed by the Board of County Commissioners of Montezuma County, Colorado, upon lands belonging to second parties required to be taken by said County for right of ways for Highway Project F. A. S. 126-B, in order that the same may be finally settled and determined, the said party of the first part and the said parties of the second part hereby agree that all differences and controversies now existing between them as to the value, damages and benefite and all matters to be determined in order to arrive at a just sum to be paid second parties for the taking of the right of ways above mentioned, be and the same are hereby submitted to the award and determination of Harry V. Pyle, Eri Neel and C. H. Rudy, who shall have full power and authority to hear and determine the said controversies, claims and demands, and shall make their award thereon in writing on or before the 20th day of August, A. D. 1938, subject to the limitation that said Arbitrators in reaching their award shall have the right only to consider three elements, (1)- the actual value of the land to be taken which amount must be allowed second parties regardless of all other considerations, (2) the damage done the remainder of the land by reason of the highway construction, (3)- the benefits accruing to the land by reason of the construction of the highway; and it is further agreed that the award so made may be filed by the successful party with the Clerk of the District Court of Montezuma County, State of Colorado, and that judgment may be entered by the Clerk upon said award.

It is further agreed that the said arbitraters shall each receive the sum of \$5.00 per day for his fees and expenses in the matter of this arbitration, the same to be taxed and allowed as part of

the costs of said arbitration.
