Resolution.

Whereas, there was created in the year 1937 the Colorado Water Conservation Board of the State of Colorado, designated to look after, protect and preserve to Colorado the waters rising in the State of Colorado and naturally belonging thereto, and other waters claimed by the State; and

Whereas, litigation is now pending and litigation threatened concerning the right of the State of Colorado to the use of water belonging to the streams of Colorado and to its People; and

Whereas, a proper and equitable distribution of the waters of the Colorado River allocated to the four upper states under the Colorado River compact has not been determined but is now being negotiated between said states by and under the agency of the said Water Conservation Board on the part of the State of Colorado; and

Whereas, important matters are now pending with respect to the waters of the State of Colorado before said Water Conservation Board; and

Whereas, the rights to the use of the waters of the State of Colorado will be imperilled unless definite action is taken to protect the same; and

Whereas, the Water Conservation Board of Colorado is the agency set up in the State for the purpose of protecting Colorado's interest in said waters and is now functioning successfully in that behalf;

Now Therefore, be it resolved that it is the sense of the Board of County Commissioners of Montezuma County, Colorado, that said Water Conservation Board be continued, and that funds be provided for its operation; that a copy of this resolution be sent to the Governor of the State, to the President of the State Senate, to the Speaker of the House of Representatives of the State and to the Water Conservation Board of the State.

Resolution;

Whereas, the Thirty-first General Assembly of the State of Colorado approved and authorized by adoption of House Joint Resolution No. 14, the state's participation in the Golden Gate International Exposition at San Francisco in 1939; and

Whereas, under the provisions of House Joint Resolution No. 14, Governor Teller Ammons created a Colorado commission to finance, arrange and supervise a Colorado exhibit at said Golden Gate International Exposition; and

Whereas, the said Colorado commission, acting with the knowledge of Chapter 45, Section 37, Vol. 2, Colorado annotated statutes, authorizing Boards of County Commissioners of the State of Colorado to appropriate funds for the encouraging immigration and increasing trade in Colorado products, has pro-rated expenses of said Colorado exhibit at the Golden Gate International Exposition among counties, fairly and equitably, on a basis of assessed valuation;

Now, Therefore Be It Resolved, By the Board of County Commissioners of Montezuma County, in regular meeting convened, under authority granted by Chapter 45, Section 37, Vol. 2, Colorado annotated statutes, hereby approve participation of Montezuma County, and hereby pledge and appropriate the sum of \$56.00 to said Colorado commission Golden Gate International Exposition, as payment of said Montezuma County's quota of Colorado's participation in said Golden Gate International Exposition.

An offer of \$280.00 for Tax Sale Certificate #8122 covering the 1928 taxes on the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec 9, Twp, 36, R 16 including all subsequent taxes and an offer of \$100.00 covering the 1932 taxes on the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec 13, Twp 37, R 16 including all subsequent taxes, were rejected.

The Clerk was instructed by the Board to write the following letter and send copies to Hon. Edward T. Taylor, Representative, Hon. Alva B. Adams, Senator and Hon. Ed C. Johnson, Senator at Washington:

The matter of abandonment of twenty-eight miles of the Rio Grande Railroad between Vance Junction and Rico will be considered by the Interstate Commerce Commission in the near future. The abandonment of this much of the road would be very damaging to the mining interests of this section of the State, and all of the Counties affected are united upon the proposition that this abandonment should not be made.

The receiver of the railroad has, or is making application to the Reconstruction Finance Corporation for a loan of \$100,000 to be expended largely in the rehabilitation of the road. It seems almost necessary that money be raised from this source in order to place the road on a better operating basis. The five Counties interested are also anxious to have this loan made. As one of the counties interested we will appreciate anything that you can do to see that no abandonment is made, and that a loan from the Reconstruction Finance Corporation is granted.
