RESOLUTION NO. 3-46 (Walker, McCabe, Kelly)

It is hereby Resolved by the Board of Commissioners of Montezuma County, Colorado, in adjourned session assembled this 9th day of January, 1946, that A. F. Hopper, the duly qualified and appointed Treasurer of Montezuma County, Colorado, be, and he is hereby authorized, empowered, directed and instructed to take deeds on all lands in Montezuma County on which the county holds tax sale certificates and on which the taxes are unpaid for three years or more, on those Certificates, pursuant to the provisions of the law in such case made and provided.

RESOLUTION NO. 4-46 (Walker, McCabe, Kelly)

Be it Resolved by the Board of Commissioners of Montezuma County, Colorado, in adjourned session assembled this 9th day of January, 1946, that the following policy be, and the same is hereby adopted in the matter of sale of real estate owned by Montezuma County, to-wit:

That all offers for the purchase of land owned by Montezuma County and subject to sale shall be made to the Board of County Commissioners, and if accepted by said Board, payment must be made within thirty days.

Upon all sales of real estate by Montezuma County, unless otherwise provided by proper order, Montezuma County shall reserve all oil, gas and mineral rights, together with the right of ingress and egress to remove the same, and Montezuma County shall reserve rights-of-way for roads as now constructed, or which may hereafter be constructed; and

It is further Resolved that all sales of real estate shall be made subject to taxes for the year in which the purchase was made, provided that said sale and purchase is made prior to the first day of July, 1946. In the event the sale of county property shall be made after the first day of July, 1946, then and in that event taxes shall not be levied for the year 1946.

RESOLUTION NO. 5-46 (Walker, McCabe, Kelly)

Be it Resolved by the Board of Commissioners of Montezuma County, Colorado, in adjourned session assembled this 9th day of January, 1946, that the following policy be, and the same is hereby adopted and approved in the matter of sale of Tax Certificates held by Montezuma County.

WHEREAS the United States government has made available for airport construction to the State of Colorado the sum of \$7,663,436.00; and

WHEREAS there has been authorized to the Town of Cortez, the county seat of Montezuma County, the sum of \$143,000.00 for a Class 2 airfield exclusive of cost of plans, building and land; and

WHEREAS the Town of Cortez has indicated that individually they are financially unable to provide the necessary funds to take advantage of said allotment, and has petitioned the Board of County Commissioners for their county's joint assistance; and

WHEREAS the Board of County Commissioners believes that an airport as contemplated by the government allotment may be beneficial to the entire county of Montezuma if said airport is built and constructed; and

WHEREAS it would be possible to take advantage of said federal allotment if the county of Montezuma and the Town of Cortez should jointly acquire, erect, maintain and repair said airport as provided by CAA and the above mentioned government or congressional act known as "Federal Airport Act"; and

WHEREAS the Board of County Commissioners believes that the people of Montezuma County should express their approval upon an expenditure of this type and that said approval may be obtained by a vote upon a bond issue for the purpose of purchasing and acquiring a county owned airport in a general election to be held on the first Tuesday of November A. D. 1946; and

WHEREAS it is necessary to obtain approval of said project by the CAA before the date of said election.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be it Resolved by the Board of County Commissioners in regular session assembled this 1st day of July A. D. 1946, that the Board of County Commissioners deem it advisable and necessary that in conjunction with the Town of Cortez a lease with option to purchase airport for municipal and county purposes be obtained in conformity with the rules and regulations of the CAA, suitable to meet all of said federal requirements, and to finance said program, the County Clerk and the County Attorney are hereby instructed to prepare and carry out the necessary steps required to place the matter of the acquisition and maintenance of a county owned airport before the people of Montezuma County in the next general election to be held in Montezuma County on the first Tuesday of November A. D. 1946.

Quarterly inspection of the jail was made.
