Bids of the Cortez Sentinel for county printing at the rate of .09 per line for first insertion and .06 per line for each subsequent insertion, 6-point type, one column width and of the Montezuma Valley Journal for printing stationary were received.

Bid of the Montezuma Valley Journal for printing stationery was discussed. The Board requested the Journal/^{State} to clarify their bid by making a survey of the county stationery and forms to determine just what they could print. Acceptance held in abeyance until such time as the Journal could make a report.

RESOLUTION NO. 1-49

It is hereby Resolved that pursuant to the provisions of Paragraph 38, Chapter 40, Vol. 2, 1935 Colorado Statutes annotated, the Chairman of the Board of Commissioners of Montezuma County, Colorado, be, and he is hereby nominated, constituted and appointed Commissioner to execute deeds to real estate and convey any real estate belonging to Montezuma County Colorado, upon such terms, price and conditions as the Board of County Commissioners of Montezuma County, Colorado, shall from time to time direct; and the said Chairman, as Commissioner, is hereby authorized, directed and empowered to affix to any conveyances executed in accordance with the order, the seal of Montezuma County, Colorado; and it is further resolved that all other powers heretofore conferred upon any person other than the Chairman, be and the same are hereby revoked and cancelled.

RESOLUTION NO. 2-49 ✓

It is hereby Resolved by the Board of Commissioners of Montezuma County, in adjourned session assembled, that Forest Service Funds to Montezuma County be apportioned 50% to School Funds and 50% to County Road Fund.

RESOLUTION NO. 3-49

It is hereby Resolved by the Board of Commissioners of Montezuma County, Colorado, in regular session assembled this 12 day of January 1949, that Lois S. Miller, the duly qualified and appointed Treasurer of Montezuma County, Colorado, be, and is hereby authorized, empowered, directed and instructed to take deeds on all lands in Montezuma County on which the taxes are unpaid for three years or more, on those Certificates, pursuant to the provision of the law in such case made and provided.

RESOLUTION NO. 4-49

Be it Resolved by the Board of Commissioners of Montezuma County, Colorado, in regular session assembled this 12th day of January, 1949, that the following policy be, and the same is hereby adopted in the matter of sale of real estate owned by Montezuma County, to-wit:

That all offers for the purchase of land owned by Montezuma County and subject to sale shall be made to the Board of County Commissioners, and if accepted by said Board, payment must be made within thirty days.

Upon all sales of real estate by Montezuma County, unless otherwise provided by proper order, Montezuma County shall reserve all oil, gas and mineral rights, together with the right of ingress and egress to remove the same, and Montezuma County shall reserve rights-of-way for roads as now constructed, or which may hereafter be constructed; and

It is Further Resolved that all sales of real estate shall be made subject to taxes for the year in which the purchase was made.

RESOLUTION NO. 5-49

Be it Resolved by the Board of Commissioners of Montezuma County, Colorado, in regular session assembled this 12th day of January, 1949, that the following policy be, and the same is hereby adopted and approved in the matter of Tax Certificates held by Montezuma County.

Sale of certificate shall not be permitted to any person, firm, association or corporation on land when such person, firm, association or corporation has any record interest therein, either as record owner, mortgagee or leasee.

Offers, when accepted by this Board, shall be the warrant and authority of the County Treasurer of Montezuma County, Colorado, to accept as low as the sum so offered, plus Treasurer's fees, and if sale be not completed within thirty days from the date of authorization by the Board of County Commissioners, order authorizing such sale shall be void and of no further force and effect.

RESOLUTION NO. 6-49

WHEREAS a new plate for the check signer is to be immediately ordered, but will not arrive for the Welfare Meeting of this Board;

Now, Therefore, be it Resolved by the Board of Commissioners of Montezuma County, Colorado, in regular session assembled this 12th day of January 1949, that the manual signatures of Chas. T. Porter, Chairman, and John Leavitt, Clerk, be used until the arrival of the new plate, and it is further Resolved that a copy of this Resolution be delivered to the County Treasurer.

RESOLUTION NO. 7-49

WHEREAS, Be it Resolved by the Board of Commissioners of Montezuma County, Colorado, that the Citizens State Bank, of Cortez, and the J. J. Harris & Company, Bankers, Bank, Dolores, Colorado, be, and are hereby named, designated, constituted and appointed depository banks for all funds and moneys of whatsoever kind, that shall come into the possession of the County Treasurer by virtue of his office as County Treasurer of Montezuma County, Colorado, and said banks, and each of them herein named, are approved as depository banks.

The following resolutions were adopted:

The application of Charles E. Kennedy to lease the oil, gas and other minerals lying under lots 10, 11, 14, and 15 of Section 30, township 39 N. R. 17, West NMPM owned by Montezuma County having been made to the Board of Commissioners verbally, and the Board having considered the terms of said application; It is therefore RESOLVED that the County enter into an oil and gas lease on lots 10, 11, 14 and 15 of Section 30 Twp 39, NR 17, containing 84.29 mineral acres for a term of 5 years or as long thereafter as oil and gas are being produced thereon, at a delay rental payment of \$1.00 per acre and a bonus payment of \$2.00 per acre. Be it further Resolved that Lois S. Miller, the County Treasurer is designated to execute said oil lease on behalf of Montezuma County. Be it further Resolved that said lease be on Producers 88 Special form, Kintzel Blue Print Co., Casper, Wyoming.

Inasmuch as it has been made to appear to the Board of County Commissioners that a vacancy exists in Justice of the Peace Precinct No. 3 in this county by reason of the fact that the person elected to this office did not qualify as required by law, and that need exists for the filling of the vacancy; Be it therefore **RESOLVED** that William Wagner, who is qualified as required by law for the office of Justice of the Peace, be and he is hereby appointed to fill the vacancy for Justice Precinct No. 3, until his successor is duly elected and qualified, and be it further resolved that William Wagner shall before entering the duties of his office, take the necessary oath and file the required bond, and otherwise qualify for the office as required by law, that he be notified in writing of his appointment by the Clerk of this Board.

The Board of Commissioners ruled that since Harry V. Pyle had failed to qualify for the office of Justice of the Peace in Justice Precinct No. 3, he be notified in writing by the Clerk that he is no longer a Justice of the Peace.

Whereas, the United States of America has acquired and is acquiring real property which is being operated as projects for resettlement (as defined in 49 Stat. 2035, hereinafter called the "Act"), among other purposes located within the jurisdictional limits of the local Public Taxing Unit, hereinafter set forth; and Whereas, the aforesaid project and the persons now and hereafter residing on or occupying such premises will be supplied with public or municipal services by the local public taxing unit hereinafter set forth; NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Montezuma County, Colorado that this resolution shall constitute the Request of the United States of America by and on behalf of said local public taxing unit, to enter into an agreement for the payment by the United States of sums in lieu of taxes; and BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this body does hereby authorize its Chairman to execute, for and on behalf of said local taxing unit, said agreement with the United States of America.



