
The following resolution was unanimously adopted:

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

Minutes of previous meeting read and approved.

Charles Burke and Sheriff Anderson appeared to request that Mr. Burke be sent to Phoenix, Arizona to question a woman in connection with the McEwen murder case. Board authorized payment of mileage one way, deputy's pay while engaged in county business and one half of expense--board and room.

Appeared Merton Taylor and County Treasurer Matlock to discuss remission of interest and penalty on last half of 1934 tax on Taylor property at Dolores. Flat tax of \$527.66 to be paid. The following resolution was unanimously adopted:

RESOLUTION NO. 56-8

Whereas it appears the last half of the general property taxes upon property listed with the Assessor of Montezuma County for the year 1934 due in August 1935 were not paid and did not go to sale as provided by law covering the following described property:

Lots 9-10, Block 19, Dolores, less that part described in Book 85, page 344; and

Lots 3 & north 2 feet of lot 2, Block 17, Dolores; and a Tract of land in NE corner of S¹/₄ Sec. 7, Tp 36 N, Rg 15W, and, whereas said property is not now owned by the same person against whom said taxes were levied and assessed, and whereas, present owners have offered to pay base taxes provided no penalty or interest affix, and whereas, said taxes are unpaid for a period of more than 6 years and this Board does find that interest and penalty thereon is uncollectable, Now, therefore, Be it resolved the Board of Commissioners of Montezuma County this 3rd day of March 1958 that all interest and penalty on the taxes described is hereby declared uncollectable and the Treasurer is upon payment of the base tax is authorized to accept the same in full payment.

The following resolution was also unanimously adopted:

RESOLUTION NO. 58-9

Whereas a certain change in alignment on Highway No. 160 west of Mancos, Colorado has resulted in the abandonment of certain portions of said Highway No. 160 by the State of Colorado, and, Whereas it is the opinion of this Board that certain portions of said highway should be incorporated in the County Road System and certain other portions of said highway right of way should be abandoned to adjacent property owners;


Now, therefore, be it resolved by the Board of Commissioners of Montezuma County this 3rd day of March 1958 that that portion of old Highway No. 160 from a point where the County Roads turns South in Section 31, Tp 36N, Rg 13W to a point where old Highway No. 160 intersects the east-west County road in section 16, Tp 36N, Rg 14W, be incorporated in the County Road System from the said two points to its intersection with Highway No. 160 as now constructed on the new alignment. Be it further resolved that that portion of

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
