Resolution #15-92

WHEREAS, Under CRS 29-2-101 et seq, local governments are authorized to enter into agreements with each other to cooperatively provide any function, service, or facility that each is lawfully authorized to provide; and

WHEREAS, Montezuma County and the City of Cortez have previously entered into such an intergovernmental agreement, adopted as Ordinance 549, Series 1980, by the Cortez City Council, and as Resolution 17-80 by the Montezuma Board of County Commissioners; and,

WHEREAS, said Ordinance and Resolution create an Airport Committee to jointly fund, operate, and maintain the Cortez-Montezuma Airport; and,

WHEREAS, said agreement expressly recognizes that the Airport Committee members retain all powers in the administration of the airport that each entity retains under the Cortez City Charter and the statutes of the State of Colorado; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Cortez, as the responsible entity for the financial management of the airport, and in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles, has traditionally classified the airport as an enterprise fund for budgeting and accounting purposes; and,

WHEREAS, the County finds, determines, and declares that it is necessary to the ongoing effective funding and operation of the airport that it continue to be classified within the City as an enterprise fund; and,

WHEREAS, the County wishes to fully and fairly comply with all provisions of Article X, Section 20 of the Colorado State Constitution (sometimes known as Amendment 1), as was adopted by the people on November 3, 1992.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Montezuma County, Colorado:

THAT Montezuma County Resolution 17-80 is hereby amended by the inclusion of the following additional language:

"The County, acting through the Board of County Commissioners, may issue revenue bonds or other debt instruments in the name of the Montezuma County and on behalf of the airport."
