**8. List of Prohibited Wastes for Disposal**

a. By permit/regulatory limitations:

- Potential hazardous materials and waste (non-household) in large volumes greater than 5 gallons as defined by the Hazardous Waste Commission pursuant to 25-15-302 C.R.S. and 40 CFR Part 261
- Automobile batteries (lead-acid)      ➤ Liquid waste or waste that has free-liquids (particularly waste oil, paint, septage, contaminated water or liquids)
- Computers, TVs & e-waste (defined by statute) effective 1 July 2013      ➤ Sludges, septic tank pumpings, or chemical toilet wastes not approved by county and CDPHE (dewatered/denatured POTW sludge approved)
- PCBs      ➤ Institutional wastes considered biomedical or biohazardous
- Radioactive wastes      ➤ Unlabeled 55 gallon drums (not empty),
- Tires (Residential whole)      ➤ Industrial process waste not pre-approved by county and / or CDPHE (Requires content/chemical documentation)
- Volatile and flammable waste      ➤ Yellow grease (restaurant kitchen grease traps)

b. By facility management policy.

- Hot ashes (e.g. burn barrel wastes that are “hot”)
