

**THE SOUTHWEST REGIONAL COMMUNICATIONS
MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)**

THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU) is made and entered into this 1st day of January, 2009, by and between the Southwest Regional Communication Committee and the undersigned entities;

WHEREAS, the Southwest Regional Communication Committee has placed the safety of first responders as the number one priority; and

WHEREAS, this Memorandum of Understanding will enhance the protection of first responders within the region in communications regarding any incident to keep our responders safe and, in turn, the citizens safe and confident in our ability to do so.

WHEREAS, the Southwest Regional Communication Committee (SWRCC) and the undersigned entities have previously entered into a Southwest Regional Communications Memorandum of Understanding dated January 1, 2006, which was subsequently amended, and by this Memorandum of Understanding wish to revise and replace such prior Memorandum of Understanding, in its entirety; and

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises, covenants and conditions herein set forth, the parties agree:

1. This Memorandum of Understanding is intended to authorize each undersigned entity and/or authority (Exhibit A, pages 2 through 40) to allow for each party's authorized VHF frequencies and authorized 800MHz talk groups to be programmed into the radio equipment of each undersigned entity or authority.

2. It is understood and agreed that each agency talk group / frequency will not be used by any other entity or authority for routine communications or for any other situation that does not involve mutual aid or critical emergency.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties have executed this Southwest Regional Communications Memorandum of Understanding the day and year first above written.
