# Continuity of Operations Plan (COOP).

No report this month

#### **Communications**

- Inspection of the Dolores Tower site 5/10/24 for infrastructure upgrades. Documents submitted to USDA-FS are approved. Homeland Security Grant approval obtained. Moving forward with the project in the Spring.
- County project to reprogram all 800MHz radios in the Montezuma County, Dolores County and Ute Mountain Ute Tribe began 4/1/24. Update: Vendor was selected. Working on logistics. This project should be completed by 03/15/25, depending on the scheduling, weather, and availability of equipment.
- EM submitted grant funding for a mobile Star Link for response to areas where there is no communication service.
- Secure Rural Schools Program funding for \$43,636.49 was approved by the BOCC for Emergency Management Communication Equipment. We will begin the purchasing procedure in February 2025.

## Community Emergency Response Team (CERT)

- Members are attending various trainings/exercises in Dolores/Montezuma County.
- Disaster Exercise was completed November 14<sup>th</sup>.
- CERT is preparing a float for the parade on December 7<sup>th</sup> and came in 3<sup>rd</sup> place in their category.

# Emergency Management Performance Grant (EMPG):

- 2024 EMPG Grant was submitted for \$55,390 on 01/12/24 and was approved.
- 2024 EMPG Grant 1<sup>st</sup> Qtr. submitted for \$21,438.84 and was approved. We received \$10,719.42 on 7/09/24
- 2024 EMPG Grant 2<sup>nd</sup> Qtr. submitted for \$29,566.40 and was approved. We received \$14,783.20 on 9/16/24.
- 2024 EMPG Grant 3<sup>rd</sup> Qtr. submitted for \$23,577.98 and is pending approval.
- 2024 EMPG Grant 4th Qtr. will be submitted by January 20, 2025.
- 2025 EMPG Grant application approved by BOCC and will be submitted for \$57,103 by January 10, 2025.

# Emergency Operations Plan (EOP)

• EM and Public Health EM completed the 3-year revision plan of the previous Oct 2021 EOP. Completed and approved December 10th, 2024.

# Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP):

• County generators grant project approved.

- ➤ Total Project Cost is \$170,486.40, with the FEMA Federal Share amount of \$154,249.60. End date on the grant is 2/01/27. Reimbursement requests for \$134,060.62 have been submitted awaiting approval.
- The County has begun the process to update the Hazard Mitigation Plan (HMP). This process occurs every 5 years. Actual costs were collected on the planning grant. BOCC determined a cost, and the final budget documents were completed. Waiting on Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO) to come out for the grant in 2025.

# Integrated Preparedness Plan (IPP)

- The 3-year plan for 2025-2027 for the County was finalized and submitted to the state and stakeholders on 4/16/24.
- EM is now beginning the process on updating the IPP to 2026-2028.

## Local Emergency Planning Committee (From LEPC Chair):

• EHS facility tours will begin in a few months for the generation of this year's EAP.

# **Public Information Coordinator (PIO):**

- Continuing to assist the public in getting signed up for Everbridge.
- Assisted County Admin with administrative duties.

# Southwest All Hazards Advisory Council (SWAHAC):

- EM has approved grants and status on the project for:
  - > A Star Link mobile communication system and service pending.
  - > Antennas and radio base station for EOC in progress.
  - ➤ ICS Training supplies for the ICS Training Team which is completed.
  - Communication Towers Infrastructure in progress.
  - > EOC electronics in progress.
  - ➤ Radio re-programing in progress
