Montezuma County Outdoor Recreation and Heritage Asset Inventory

Introduction

The inventory of outdoor recreation and heritage assets includes a list of trails and trail systems, activities occurring/allowed on the trails, level of difficulty, seasonality, ease of access, and jurisdiction. The inventory lists outdoor recreation facilities such as reservoirs, state wildlife areas, and other facilities. About 70 businesses directly related to outdoor recreation (including non-profit businesses) were included in the inventory spanning business categories such as retail, manufacturing, tours and guide services, youth organizations, guest ranches, and commercial campgrounds.
