

Election Information: 2025 COORDINATED ELECTION

November 4, 2025 Montezuma County General Election will be an all-mail ballot delivery. Ballots will be mailed to all active eligible registered electors starting October 10. To be counted, mail ballots must be returned to and in the hands of the Montezuma County Clerk and Recorder no later than 7:00 pm on Election Day, November 4, 2025 **Postmarks do not count.**

Important Dates

October 2, 2025 – The Logic and Accuracy test will be held at the Montezuma County Clerk and Recorder's office starting at 8:00am. This is a public test and all are welcome to attend.

October 10, 2025 – Ballots will be mailed to all eligible electors

October 27, 2025- November 4, 2025(M-F): The Cortez Vote Center is open at the Montezuma County Annex 1 at 107 N. Chestnut St from 8am-5pm. All 24/7 Ballot Dropbox locations will be open.

Saturday, November 1, 25- The Cortez Vote Center is open at the Montezuma County Annex 1 at 107 N. Chestnut St from 9am-1pm.

Tuesday, November 4 , 2025 – Election Day - Cortez, Vote Centers are open from 7am-7pm.

***Please note that the Motor Vehicle office in Cortez will be closed on Election Day. You will still be able to perform motor vehicle transactions online at dmv.colorado.gov.
