- 2025 EMPG Grant application was submitted for \$57,103. Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO)came out for the grant in July.
- 1st Qtr. reimbursement was submitted for \$21,000.12.
- 2nd Qtr. reimbursement was submitted for \$25,064.08

Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP):

 County generators grant has 98% of the project completed. 3rd Qtr. work plan and reimbursements submitted. Completion estimated September 30th for close out. Hazard Mitigation Plan planning grant was submitted August to the National Disaster Mitigation Enterprise for funding.
