Colorado Emergency Preparedness Assessment (CEPA)

Community Animal Response Team (CART)

Monthly meetings and training are being held. September meeting was cancelled due to schedule issues.

Community Emergency Response Team (CERT)

 Monthly meetings and training are being held. September training was on patient surge exercise response at the hospital.

Continuity of Operations Plan (COOP).

All 7 COOPs completed for county buildings except one. Road and Bridge will begin there planning COOP once a new Director is appointed.

Communications

 The inspection of the Dolores Tower site was on 5/10/24 for infrastructure upgrades. Documents submitted to USDA-FS are approved. Department of Homeland Security Grant approval obtained. Waiting on DHS 2023 funding to re-open to complete fencing upgrade.

- Grant submission for a new generator at the Dolores tower site through Homeland Security (SHSP) grant for \$30,800. Pending approval in November.
- Cameras installed at Dolores site for security purposes.
- Updated Everbridge groups and test messages sent.

Emergency Management Performance Grant (EMPG):

- 2025 EMPG Grant application was submitted for \$57,103. Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO) came out for the grant in July. New funding for 9 months was \$48,181. Waiting on funding option for the 4th QTR to be announced.
- 1st Qtr. reimbursement was submitted for \$21,000.12.
- 2nd Qtr. reimbursement was submitted for \$25,064.08
- 3rd Qtr. reimbursement is pending submission in October.

Emergency Operations Center (EOC):

- Upgraded to three refurbished EOC laptops for operations.
- Printer system is operabable.
- Portable 800MHz radio system up and running for the primary EOC and Alternate EOCs
- Auxiliary Communications System (HAM Radio, computer and antenna) installed at the primary EOC and can use Winlink Global Radio Email system.

Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP):

- County generators grant project completed. All final reimbursements submitted. Close out letter submitted. Estimated final amount for reimbursements will be \$154,249.60.
- Hazard Mitigation Plan planning grant was submitted 8/28/25 to the National Disaster Mitigation Enterprise for funding. Awards will be issued by November. Submission was \$121,138.

Integrated Preparedness Plan (IPP)

• Completed. Updated plan will begin in May 2026.

Local Emergency Planning Committee (From LEPC Chair):

• Local Emergency Planning Committee meetings were held. Scheduling inspections of facilities for October.

Southwest All Hazards Advisory Council (SWAHAC):

- EM has been approved for no-match grants. These grants do not pass through the County for financial support or approval. They are an outside fiscal agent.
- Status on the projects are:
 - > Antennas and radio base station for EOC CANCELLED No longer needed
 - > Communication Towers Infrastructure on hold waiting for the grant to re-open.
 - > Alternate EOC electronics on hold waiting for the grant to re-open.
 - > CERT training and equipment on hold waiting for the grant to re-open.
 - > SW Regional Exercise on hold waiting for the grant to re-open.

- EM attended a small portion of G-197 Access Functional Needs training 9/23/25
- EM attended a tabletop exercise with RE-1 on critical incidents on 9/23/25
